- Handy Hunter (2 rounds)
 - *Handy Hunter is similar to Working Hunter where the horse is judged on a course of obstacles that simulate obstacles found in a hunting field: fences, brush and walls. Depending on the division, obstacles can range in height from 18" to 3 feet 3 inches. This class differs from Working Hunter in that the course requires an in-and-out combination jump, a trot fence, and a least two changes of direction. Manners, style of jumping, maneuverability, flow of strides and balance are elements that judges consider when marking a score. *The first round will be a regular hunter course, the second round will be classic "Handy Hunter".*
